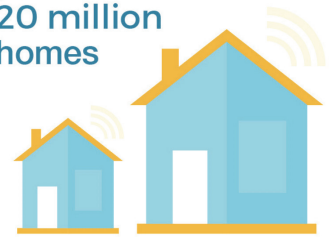
### Generation by Capacity
