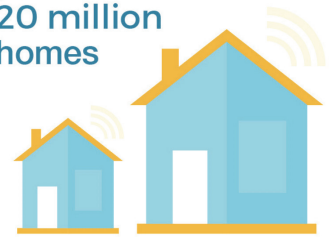
Generation by Capacity
