

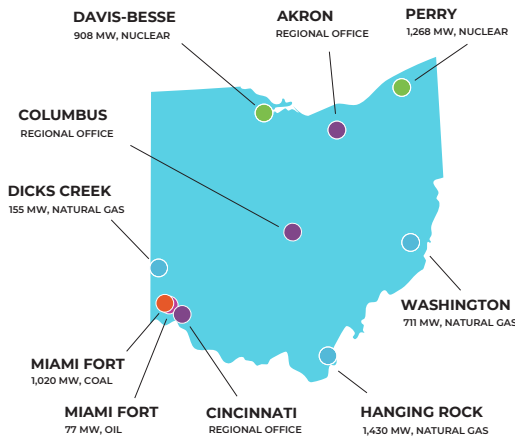


OHIO AT A GLANCE

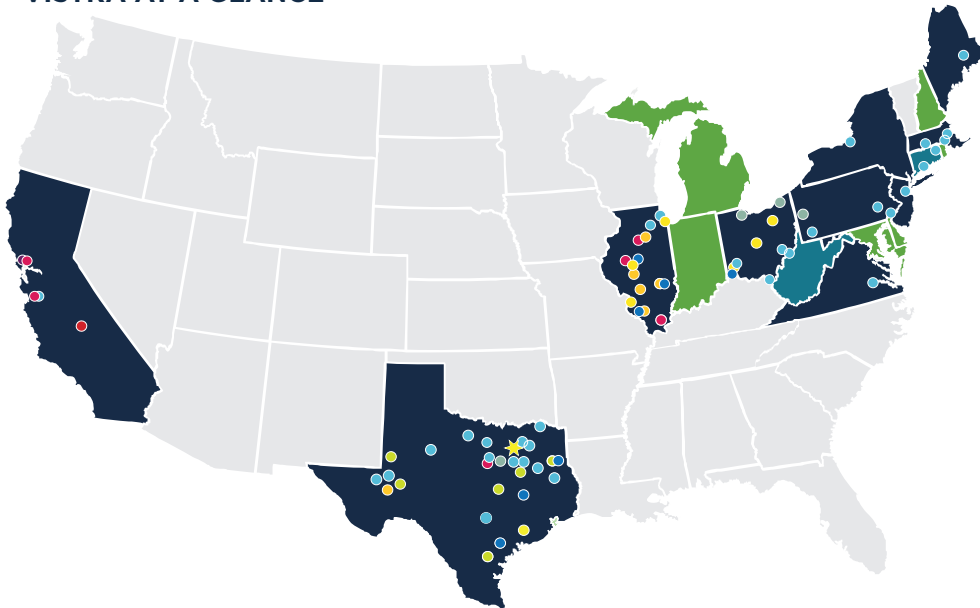

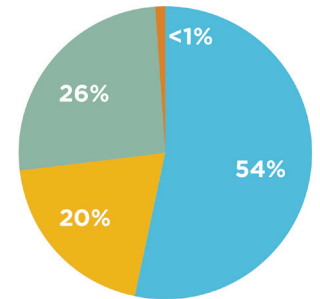
