

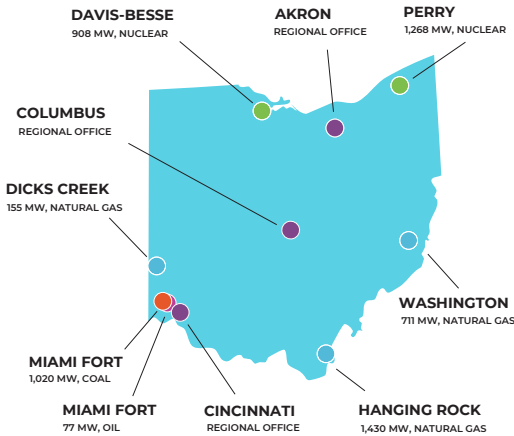


## OHIO AT A GLANCE

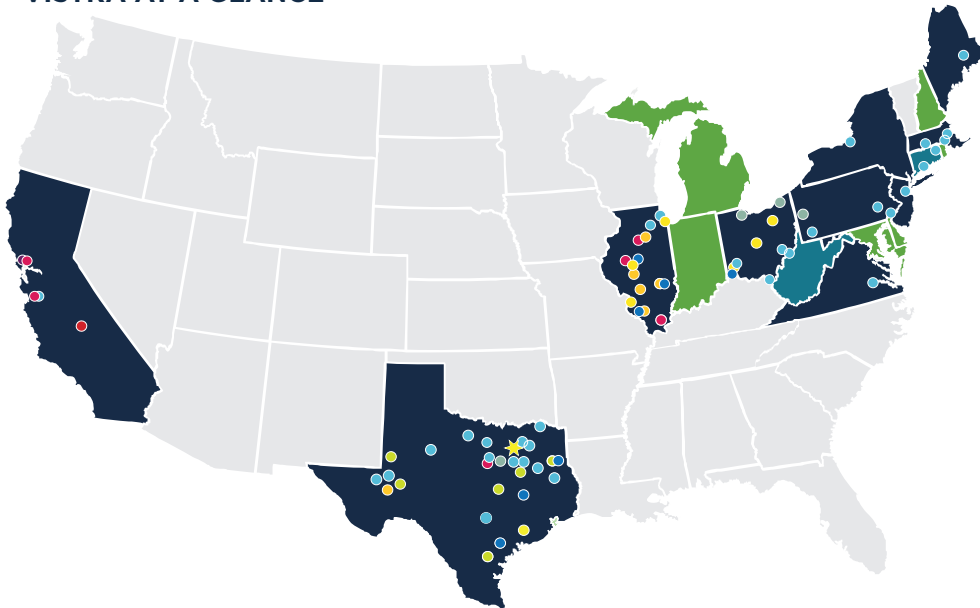

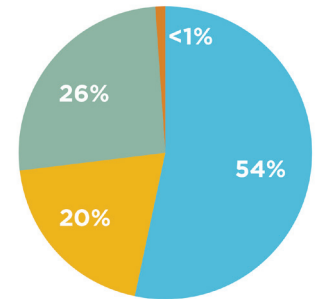
